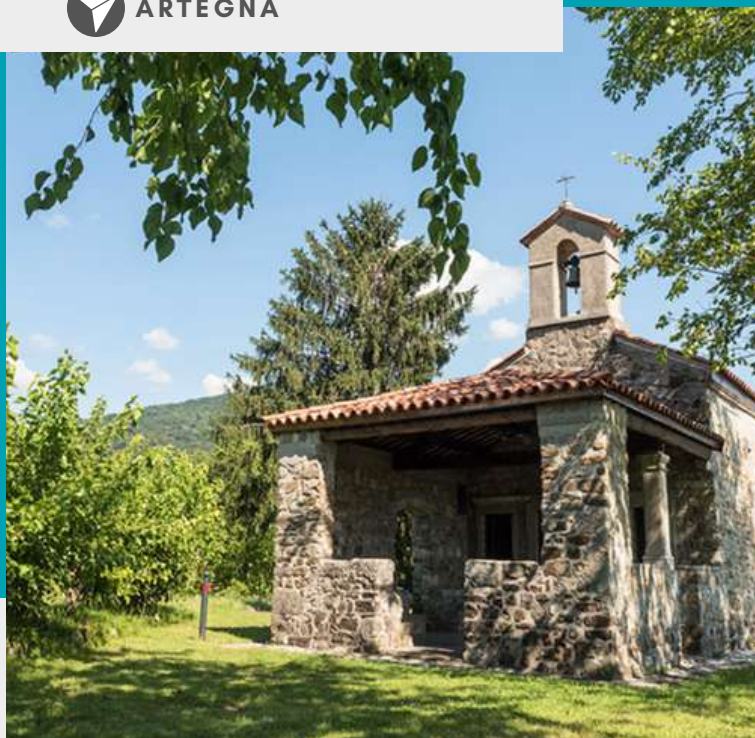

Church of San Leonardo, Parco delle Rose, Church of Santo Stefano in Clama, Colle di San Martino (Savorgnan Castle, archaeological park and Church of San Martino), return to the Church of San Leonardo;

circular route 5 km, approx. 60'
medium difficulty

trois des Cascades-Sentiero delle Cascades (Artegna and Montenars)

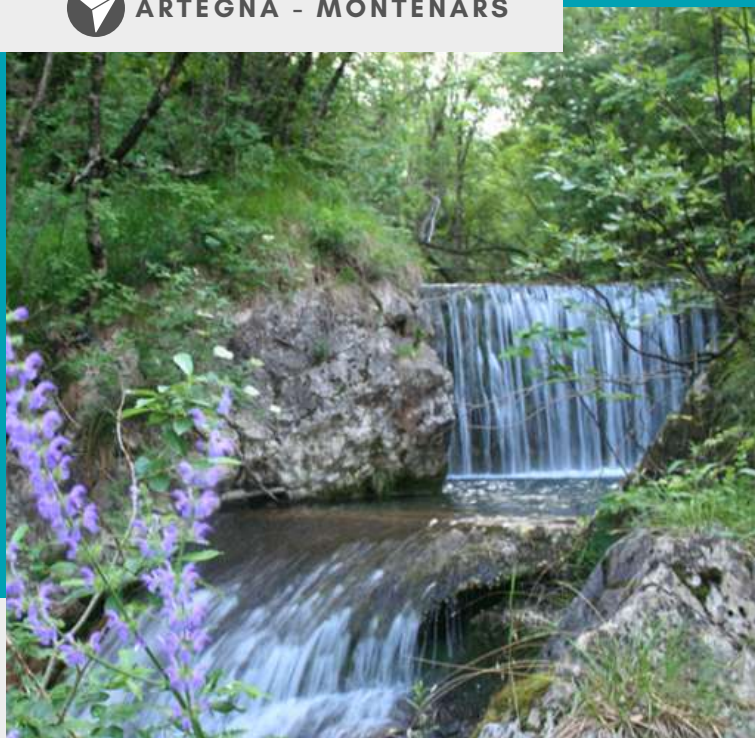

circular route: 1,5 km, about 20' + time for the exhibition

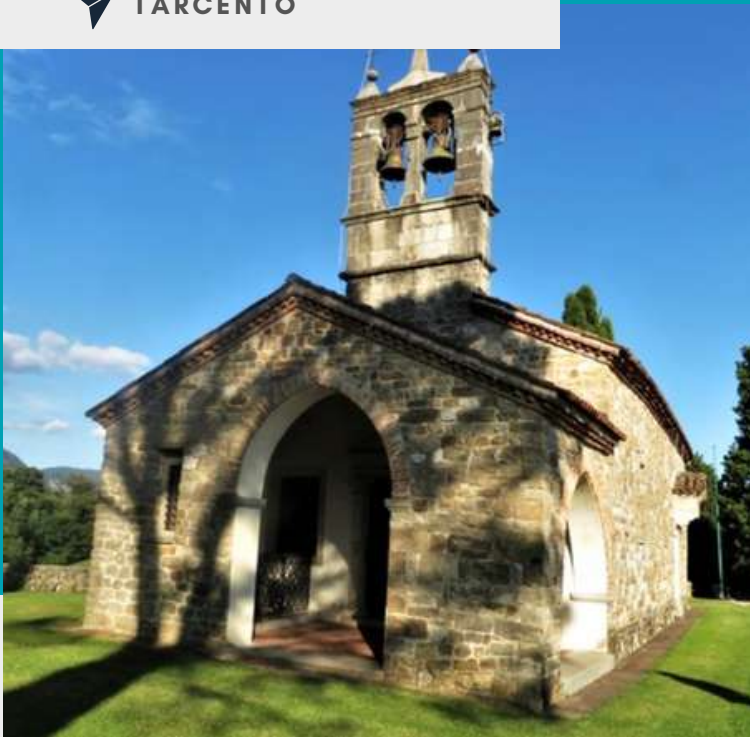
Tarcento, suburb Segnacco
